Before adjournment the Clerk raised two pressing issues-

Planning application 261006, The Lamb Inn, Stoke Prior had received a number of objections. The Clerk suggested that the Planning Committee should visit the site to see the situation on the ground so that Council could be best informed before making comment. The closing date for comments was imminent and though the Clerk had asked for an extension a reply had not yet been received. It was a matter of urgency that the site visit be made as soon as possible and the Clerk would arrange forthwith. All Councillors would be welcome to join the Planning Committee on that visit.

The Clerk asked that the proposed payments should be authorised and Council agreed that the payments should be made as listed in the meeting papers.
